OU Chorale and Chorus adds extra concert dates

The Oakland University Chorale and Chorus, under the direction of Dr. Michael Mitchell, has added extra concert dates to accommodate the growing audience of this popular performance ensemble.

The performances are Thursday and Friday, April 5 and 6, at 8 p.m. in Varner Recital Hall.

The versatile, professional student group will perform the works of Handel, Victoria, Brahms, Knauf, Scliar and others. Highlights include "Swell the Full Chorus" from the Oratorio "Solomon" by George Frederick Handel, "O Schone Nacht" from Opus 92 for piano and chorus by Johannes Brahms, the choral classic "O Magnum Mysterium" by Thomas Luis de Victoria and the Moses Hogan arrangement of the great spiritual "Elijah Rock."

Contemporary choral music by Miami composer Greg Knauf and Iowa composer Allen Koepke, folk songs of Brazil and Canada, and a special appearance by the Oakland University Women's Chorus also will be featured.

Tickets are \$5 for students, \$8 for seniors and OU employees, and \$10 for general admission.
