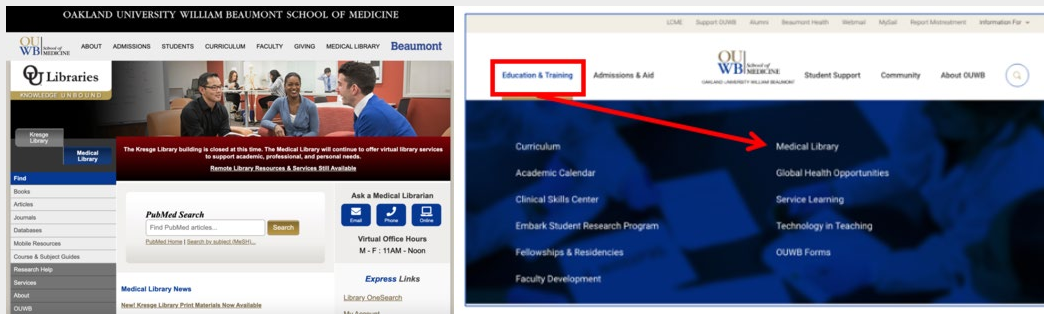

## Kresge Library Building Phased Reopening

OU Libraries and the Medical Library are working diligently to reopen the Kresge Library building safely for our students, faculty, and staff! It is anticipated it will reopen to the campus mid-August and we thank you for your patience as we ensure all precautions are in place! Library policies and procedures will follow Oakland University and the Governor's executive orders, as well as guidelines from the CDC and Michigan Division of Health.

As we start a new academic year, we have arranged alternatives for accessing our materials and for offering additional study space until the building reopens:

- **Medical Library Textbooks 24 Hour Checkout** - Textbooks that are typically only available for use in the library building will be temporarily available for a 24 hour checkout period to our medical students. Your personal librarian will be sending you more information on the process for requesting items soon! Pick up hours will be scheduled Monday - Friday between 8 a.m. - 5 p.m.
  - **Medical Library Technology Items 1 Week Checkout** - Our circulating iPads, Bamboo drawing tablet, and laptop with Comprehensive Meta-Analysis software installed are also available for a 1 week loan period on a first come, first served basis. Please submit your request to [medref@oakland.edu](mailto:medref@oakland.edu) and we will arrange a day and pick-up window with you.
  - **Study Spaces in O'Dowd Hall** - Study space is available in O'Dowd in the breakout rooms, student lounge, classrooms, and meeting rooms. Please observe posted occupancy limits, wear masks, and practice social distancing. O'Dowd is open 7 a.m. - 11 p.m. Monday - Saturday and by badge access on Sunday.
  - **Student Printing** - Printing will be available in the Medical Student Lounge in O'Dowd.

## Library Circulating Print Materials Now Available for Pick-up

As part of its phased reopening plan, Kresge Library is now able to offer expanded services and access to collections to the campus.

- **Request circulating print books** for pick-up, inter-campus mail delivery, or mailed to your home by searching and submitting book requests in [LibraryOneSearch](#). Please note that reference materials cannot be checked out.
- **Request scanned copies of book chapters or articles** from Kresge's print collection using [Kresge Library's Copy Service](#). This service is now available for faculty, staff, and students.
- **Returning books** - Books can now be returned to the outdoor dropbox on the O'Dowd side of the library's main entrance.

## OUWB Publication List: Q3 April - June 2020

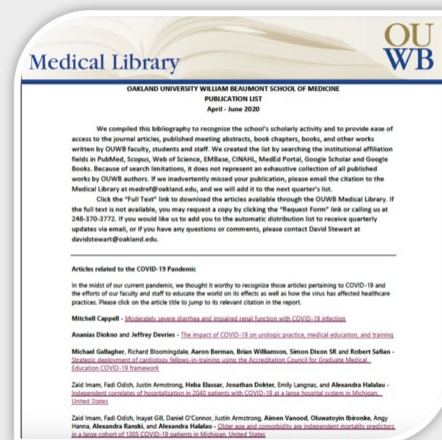
