Grizz Facts: A look at earned credits at graduation

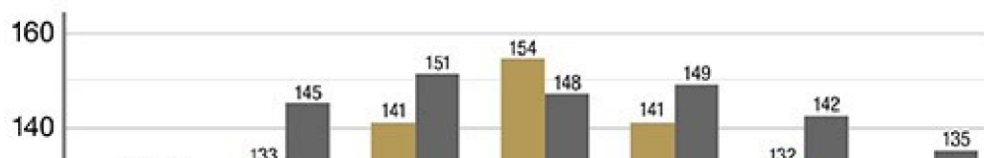
Historically, only about 13 percent of undergraduate students complete their degree with the minimum number of required credits for their academic program.

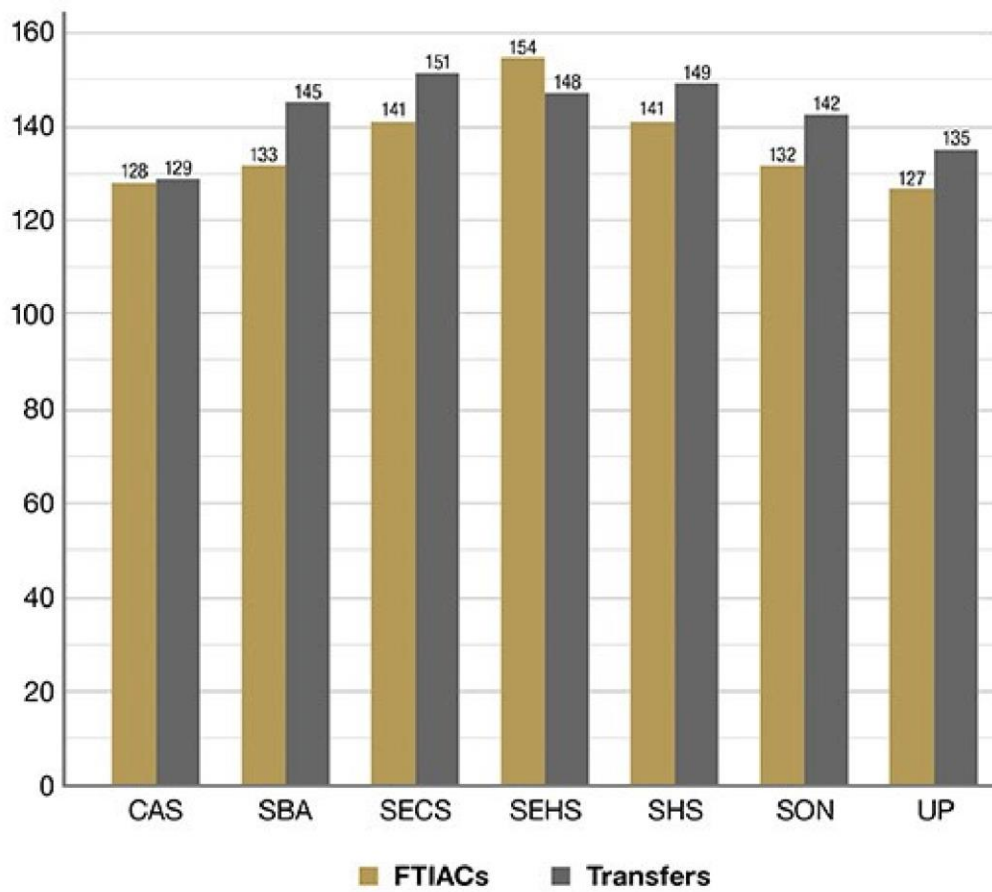
Some students earn added college credits while taking courses in high school. Other credits may be earned based on student interest in courses not required for their degree, or awarded based on nuances in transfer agreements.

Generally, transfer students graduate with more credits than students who start their college studies at OU.
