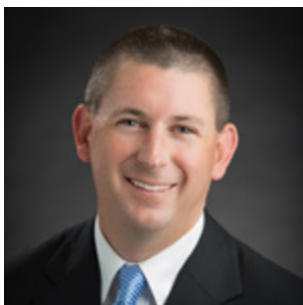


Students Awarded Student Teaching Scholarships

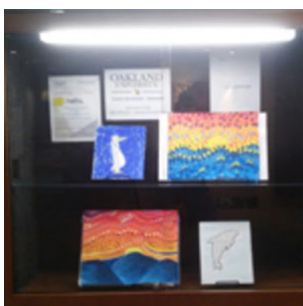


Daniel Quinn's Proposal Accepted in AERA

OUCARES will host an evening enrichment, titled *Autism, Athletics, and Activities: Empower Your Child to Learn Social Skills Through Engagement*, on February 23 from 6-7:30 p.m. in the Oakland Center, Gold Room C.

The event will be presented by Ron Sandison, an adult with ASD and the author of *A Parent's Guide to Autism*.

- how social skill learning can be facilitated through athletics and special interests
- strategies to help children break free from video games and isolation

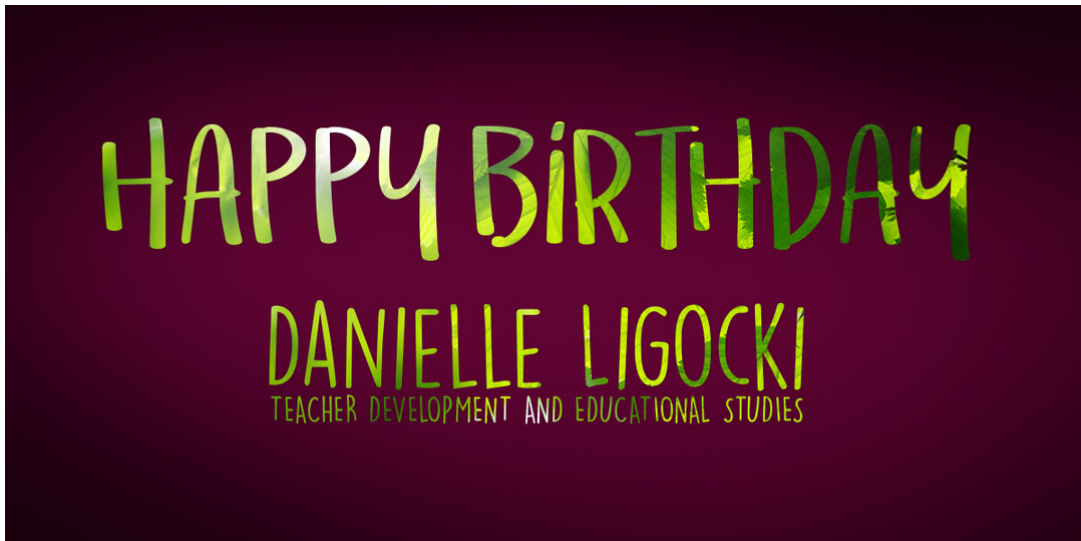


"Night School" Film Screening - March 24 2017

Andrew Cohn is an Emmy Award-winning documentary filmmaker and screenwriter living in New York. His most recent film, *Night School*, premiered at the 2016 Tribeca Film Festival and was supported by a MacArthur grant.
