OU finishes sixth in college bowl tournament

Oakland University's College Bowl team recently placed sixth among some of the top schools at the College Bowl Regional Tournament in Ohio. The team defeated teams from Wayne State University, Central Michigan, Alma College, Wilmington College, Xavier and Kent State.

The OU team was defeated by the University of Michigan, Case Western Reserve, Ohio Wesleyan, Michigan State and Ohio State.

"We consider this to be quite an accomplishment considering our captain was not able to attend," said senior Chuck Archer. "We were extremely proud to represent Oakland."

Next year the team hopes to make the final four and eventually see an established program on OU's campus.
