Dean's list announced for 2003-2004

The hard work and dedication of Oakland University's top students is recognized on the recently announced **2003-2004 dean's list**.

The dean's list is a compilation of students who distinguish themselves academically by attaining a grade point average of 3.60 or higher for 12 numerically graded credits in each of the consecutive fall/winter semesters. Students who receive an I (incomplete) and/or P (progress) grade in either the fall or winter semesters are not eligible for the list.

This year, 1,039 students are named on the list, which will be shared with local newspapers. Some students who qualified for the dean's list have requested their names not be published for privacy reasons.

"Reviewing the dean's list brings a lot of pride in our students' academic accomplishments," said Virinder Moudgil, vice president for academic affairs and provost. "It is remarkable that our students perform at the level they do while simultaneously carrying a class load, working on various research projects and participating in internship and co-op programs.

"The dean's list represents our celebration of student tenacity, commitment and dedication to their career goals. We are pleased to salute our best and brightest."

OU's dean's list is posted once a year following the winter semester for the previous academic year.
