Math and Statistics Department honors student

Oakland University's **Department of Mathematics and Statistics** recently named mathematics major and Royal Oak resident Dan Steffy as the recipient of the Louis R. Bragg Graduating Senior Award.

The award, established in 1995 through an endowment given by Professor Emeritus Bragg, is made annually to the outstanding graduating senior mathematics or statistics major as determined by a faculty committee.

Steffy was honored earlier this year by The Honors College as the inaugural recipient of the Honors College Colloquium. His Honors College project, titled "Have the Red Wings made the playoffs yet," used mixed integer programming to determine when hockey teams qualify for or are eliminated from playoff status.
