

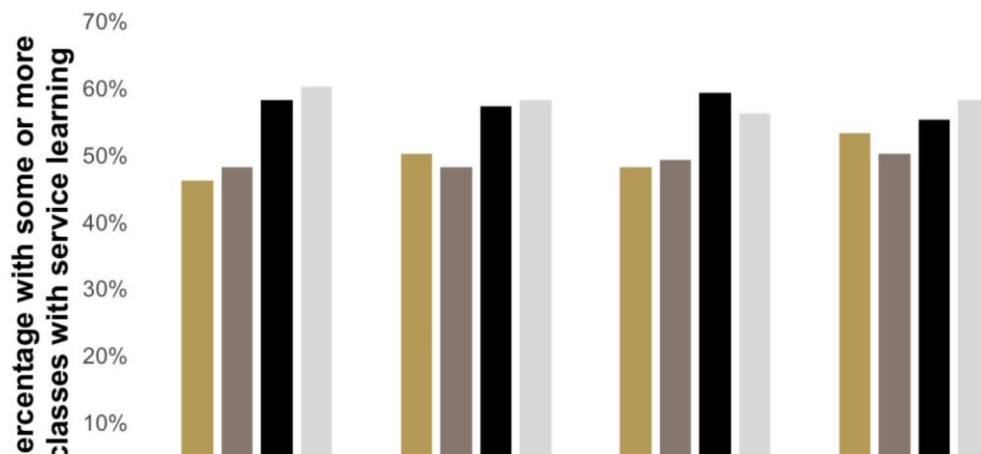


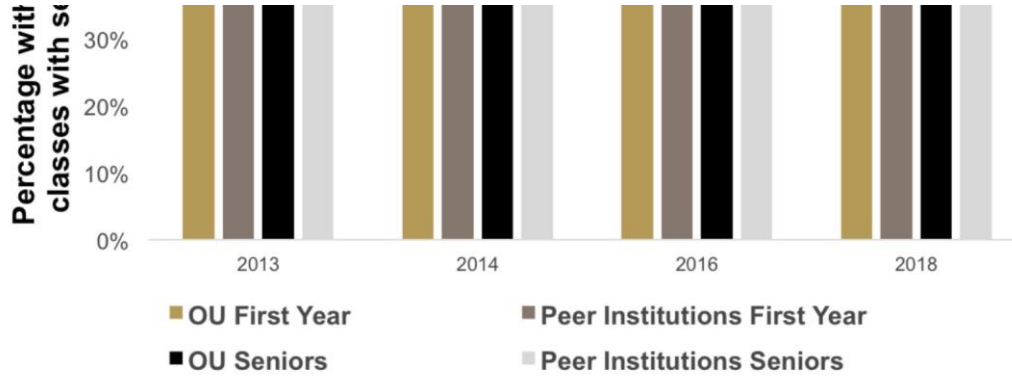

Grizz Facts: A look at service learning courses

In recent years, OU students have participated in service learning at comparable rates to students at peer universities. In fact, in 2016 OU students reported more courses with service learning than seniors at peer institutions. Nearly half of first-year students and over half of seniors indicated that some of their courses at OU included a community-based project in 2018.
