OU Center for Autism Hosts Workshop on Healthy Sexuality

On October 25 and 26, the Center for Autism at Oakland University hosted a two-day advanced workshop on autism and healthy sexuality. The workshop, held at the MEEMIC Insurance Company in Auburn Hills, provided more in-depth information as a follow-up to the conference held on March 31 on autism, sexuality, and the law. Dr. Isabelle Henault, Sexologist and Psychologist from Montreal Canada, presented extensive information on the topic of sexual development, healthy relationships, emotional development, appropriate and inappropriate sexual behaviors, consent, and the law.

Henault, a renowned researcher in the area of autism and sexuality and the author of several books, including, *Asperger's Syndrome and Sexuality: From Adolescence Through Adulthood*, shared research findings on sexual development and shared specific techniques for working with individuals on the autism spectrum.

- Knowing if the animal is the right fit
- Having realistic expectations of pet ownership and the human-animal bond
