### iPad Checkout Policy Update

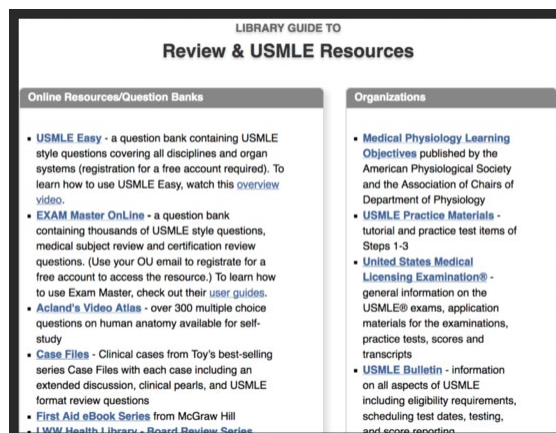
